- Uploads data to the CAQH portal nightly and flags any sanctioned providers on an organization’s roster.
- Includes a screen capture of the sanction in the alert along with additional details a plan may need.
- Enables custom reporting and on-demand searches by provider name, state, date range or sanctions type.
